

Answer the call. Recycle your old cell phones to help save gorillas.

Recycling your old cell phone helps reduce the demand for coltan, an ore being mined in the Congo in the middle of endangered gorilla habitats. Coltan is the source of the element tantalum, which is an essential coating for components of cell phones. The U.N. has reported that in the past five years, the eastern lowland gorilla population in the Congo has declined 90%. Reducing the demand for coltan will help save these animals and their habitat.

For every cell phone returned, Eco-Cell will make a donation to the Calgary Zoo's Conservation Outreach fund, which supports ape conservation initiatives, including projects for gorillas.
